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



Q. Does a flight instructor need to note the student's name, or anything particular that they must put in their log?

A. The flight instructor does not need to note the student's name in his own log, EXCEPT that FAR 61.189(b)(1) and (2) state what is required of a flight instructor's own records with regard to making endorsements for student pilot solo flights, and endorsements for knowledge or practical tests.

(The knowledge test is the "written" test that applicants take at a computerized test facility; the practical test is the oral exam and "flight check.")

Also, Advisory Circular (AC) 61-65D contains pretty comprehensive guidance on endorsements that should be made, when they are needed, and what they should say.

AC 61-65D is available on line, www.faa.gov.
Then under Regulatory/Advisory, click on Advisory Circulars.
Then click on Regulation and Certification Advisory Circulars.
Under Current AC's, click on By Number
Click on Next
Scroll down to AC 61-65D and click on the link.

Q. What if a log is falsified - what is the penalty?

A. The FAA's Compliance & Enforcement Handbook, FAA Order 2150.3, indicates that falsification of records, when that can be proven, is grounds for revocation of the airman's certificate.

- (a) Pilot certificate. A person may not act as pilot in command or in any other capacity as a required pilot flight crewmember of a civil aircraft of U.S. registry, unless that person has a valid pilot certificate or special purpose pilot authorization issued under this part in that person's physical possession or readily accessible in the aircraft when exercising the privileges of that pilot certificate or authorization. However, when the aircraft is operated within a foreign country, a current pilot license issued by the country in which the aircraft is operated may be used.
- (b) Required pilot certificate for operating a foreign-registered aircraft. A person may not act as pilot in command or in any other capacity as a required pilot flight crewmember of a civil aircraft of foreign registry within the United States, unless that person's pilot certificate:
 - Is valid and in that person's physical possession, or readily accessible in the aircraft when exercising the privileges of that pilot certificate; and
 - (2) Has been issued under this part, or has been issued or validated by the country in which the aircraft is registered.
- c) Medical certificate.
 - (1) Except as provided for in paragraph (c)(2) of this section, a person may not act as pilot in command or in any other capacity as a required pilot flight crewmember of an aircraft under a certificate issued to that person under this part, unless that person has a current and appropriate medical certificate that has been issued under Part 67 of this chapter, or other documentation acceptable to the Administrator, which is in that person's physical possession or readily accessible in the aircraft.
 - (2) A person is not required to meet the requirements of paragraph (c)(1) of this section if that person —
 - Is exercising the privileges of a student pilot certificate while seeking a pilot certificate with a glider category rating or balloon class rating;
 - Is holding a pilot certificate with a balloon class rating and is piloting or providing training in a balloon as appropriate;
 - (iii) Is holding a pilot certificate or a flight instructor certificate with a glider category rating, and is piloting or providing training in a glider, as appropriate;

(iv) Except as provided in paragraph (c)(2)(iii) of this section, is exercising the privileges of a flight instructor certificate, provided the person is not acting as pilot in command or as a required pilot flight crewmember;

- (v) Is exercising the privileges of a ground instructor certificate;
- (vi) Is operating an aircraft within a foreign country using a pilot license issued by that country and possesses evidence of current medical qualification for that license; or
- (vii) Is operating an aircraft with a U.S. pilot certificate, issued on the basis of a foreign pilot license, issued under §61.75 of this part, and holds a current medical certificate issued by the foreign country that issued the foreign pilot license, which is in that person's physical possession or readily accessible in the aircraft when exercising the privileges of that airman certificate.
- (d) Flight instructor certificate.
 - (1) A person who holds a flight instructor certificate issued under this part must have that certificate, or other documentation acceptable to the Administrator, in that person's physical possession or readily accessible in the aircraft when exercising the privileges of that flight instructor certificate. [Editorial correction.]
 - (2) Except as provided in paragraph (d)(3) of this section, no person other than the holder of a flight instructor certificate issued under this part with the appropriate rating on that certificate may —
 - Give training required to qualify a person for solo flight and solo cross-country flight;
 - (ii) Endorse an applicant for a
 - (A) Pilot certificate or rating issued under this part;
 - (B) Flight instructor certificate or rating issued under this part; or
 - (C) Ground instructor certificate or rating issued under this part;
 - (iii) Endorse a pilot logbook to show training given; or
 - (iv) Endorse a student pilot certificate and logbook for solo operating privileges.

(iv) The holder of a pilot certificate with a lighter-than-air category rating when operating a balloon; or

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 (v) The holder of a recreational pilot certificate operating under the provisions of §61.101(h).

61.33 TESTS: GENERAL PROCEDURE

Tests prescribed by or under this part are given at times and places, and by persons designated by the Administrator.

61.35 KNOWLEDGE TEST: PREREQUISITES AND PASSING GRADES

- An applicant for a knowledge test must have:
 Received an endorsement, if required by this part, from an authorized instructor certifying that the applicant accomplished the appropriate ground-training or a home-study course required by this part for the certificate or rating sought and is prepared for the knowledge test;
 - and
 2) Proper identification at the time of application that contains the applicant's —

(i) Photograph;(ii) Signature;

61.37 KNOWLEDGE TESTS: CHEATING OR OTHER UNAUTHORIZED CONDUCT

- (a) An applicant for a knowledge test may not:
 - Copy or intentionally remove any knowledge test;
 - (2) Give to another applicant or receive from another applicant any part or copy of a knowledge test;
 - (3) Give assistance on, or receive assistance on, a knowledge test during the period that test is being given;
 - (4) Take any part of a knowledge test on behalf of another person;
 - (5) Be represented by, or represent, another person for a knowledge test;
 - (6) Use any material or aid during the period that the test is being given, unless specifically authorized to do so by the Administrator; and
 - (7) Intentionally cause, assist, or participate in any act prohibited by this paragraph.

- (b) An applicant who the Administrator finds has committed an act prohibited by paragraph (a) of this section is prohibited, for 1 year after the date of committing that act, from:
 - Applying for any certificate, rating, or authorization issued under this chapter; and
 - (2) Applying for and taking any test under this chapter.
- (c) Any certificate or rating held by an applicant may be suspended or revoked if the Administrator finds that person has committed an act prohibited by paragraph (a) of this section.

61.39 PREREQUISITES FOR PRACTICAL TESTS

- (a) Except as provided in paragraphs (b) and (c) of this section, to be eligible for a practical test for a certificate or rating issued under this part, an applicant must:
 - Pass the required knowledge test within the 24-calendar-month period preceding the month the applicant completes the practical test, if a knowledge test is required;
 - (2) Present the knowledge test report at the time of application for the practical test, if a knowledge test is required:

 (3) Have satisfactorily accomplished the required training and obtained the aeronautical experience prescribed by this part for the certificate or rating sought;
 - Hold at least a current third-class medical certificate, if a medical certificate is required;

 - (6) Have an endorsement, if required by this part, in the applicant's logbook or training record that has been signed by an authorized instructor who certifies that the applicant —

 - (ii) Is prepared for the required practical test; and
 - (iii) Has demonstrated satisfactory knowledge of the subject areas in which the applicant was deficient on the airman knowledge test; and
 - (7) Have a completed and signed application form.
- (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraphs (a)(1) and (2) of this section, an applicant for an airline transport pilot certificate or an additional rating to an airline transport certificate may take the practical test for that certificate or rating with an expired knowledge test report, provided that the applicant:

(c) Notwithstanding the type of aircraft used during the practical test, the applicant and the examiner (and any other occupants authorized to be on board by the examiner) are not subject to the requirements or limitations for the carriage of passengers that are specified in this chapter.

61.49 RETESTING AFTER FAILURE

- (a) An applicant for a knowledge or practical test who fails that test may reapply for the test only after the applicant has received:
 - The necessary training from an authorized instructor who has determined that the applicant is proficient to pass the test; and
 - (2) An endorsement from an authorized instructor who gave the applicant the additional training.
- (b) An applicant for a flight instructor certificate with an airplane category rating or, for a flight instructor certificate with a glider category rating, who has failed the practical test due to deficiencies in instructional proficiency on stall awareness, spin entry, spins, or spin recovery must:
 - Comply with the requirements of paragraph (a) of this section before being retested:
 - (2) Bring an aircraft to the retest that is of the appropriate aircraft category for the rating sought and is certificated for spins; and
 - (3) Demonstrate satisfactory instructional proficiency on stall awareness, spin entry, spins, and spin recovery to an examiner during the retest.

61.51 PILOT LOGBOOKS

- (a) Training time and aeronautical experience. Each person must document and record the following time in a manner acceptable to the Administrator:
 - Training and aeronautical experience used to meet the requirements for a certificate, rating, or flight review of this part.
 - (2) The aeronautical experience required for meeting the recent flight experience requirements of this part.
- (b) Logbook entries. For the purposes of meeting the requirements of paragraph (a) of this section, each person must enter the following information for each flight or lesson logged:
 - (1) General -
 - (i) Date.
 - (ii) Total flight time or lesson time.
 - (iii) Location where the aircraft departed and arrived, or for lessons in a flight simulator or flight training device, the location where the lesson occurred.

 - (v) Training received in a flight simulator or flight training device from an authorized instructor.
- Conditions of flight
 - (i) Day or night.
 - (ii) Actual instrument.
 - Simulated instrument conditions in flight, a flight simulator, or a flight training device.
- training device.
 (c) Logging of pilot time. The pilot time described in this section may be used to:
 - Apply for a certificate or rating issued under this part; or
 - (2) Satisfy the recent flight experience requirements of this part.
- (d) Logging of solo flight time. Except for a student pilot performing the duties of pilot in command of an airship requiring more than one pilot flight crewmember, a pilot may log as solo flight time only that flight time when the pilot is the sole occupant of the aircraft.
- (e) Logging pllot-in-command flight time.
 - A recreational, private, or commercial pilot may log pilot-in-command time only for that flight time during which that person

- (a) A flight instructor must sign the logbook of each person to whom that instructor has given flight training or ground training.
- A flight instructor must maintain a record in a logbook or a separate document that contains the following:
 - (1) The name of each person whose logbook or student pilot certificate that instructor has endorsed for solo flight privileges, and the date of the endorsement; and

- Aircraft ratings. A flight instructor may not conduct flight training in any aircraft for which the flight instructor does not hold;

The record that indicates an activity recorded for N3056P and Hani Hanjour on 4/15/99 was a PTRS record indicating I reviewed an airman file submitted by DPE Daryl Strong for Hani Hanjoor's Commercial Pilot practical test.

I review airman files submitted by approximately 23 of the 38 or so designated pilot examiners in our district. The one you are asking about was, like all the rest, a review of the FAA Form 8710-1, temporary airman certificate, superseded airman certificate, and knowledge test results. The pilot examiner also attaches an FAA Form 8000-36 (PTRS data sheet, Program Tracking & Reporting Subsystem) that has been customized for the DPE's use. The default "Inspector Name Code" for DPE Daryl Strong's PTRS data sheets is "CMC," which is my initials.

Unfortunately, there are no notes or anything I could provide to you. These are simply a review of paperwork. I wish I could help you more.

I do know, however, that Daryl Strong is very willing to help out with all the investigative efforts of FBI, DOT OIG, etc. If you would like to contact him because he did have personal contact with Hani Hanjoor, please let me know and I can arrange that. Also, another DPE Duncan Hastie had personal contact with Hani Hanjoor and has been interviewed extensively by the FBI.



Mohammed Seif lied about his name and Social Security number on job application forms for Mesa Air Group.

According to a new federal indictment released Thursday, Malek

The indictment says Seif's work papers were filed last November with Air Midwest Airlines, a subsidiary.

Rodena Turner, vice president for human resources at Mesa Air Group, said Seif was hired as a pilot under his assumed name, Malek Abdallah.

"But he never completed training," Turner added.

If Seif had not flunked out, he might have been flying passenger airliners across the nation. Mesa Air Group operates 116 aircraft in a nationwide consortium of commuter airlines with flights to 153 cities.

Turner said her company conducted a background check, but Seif got a Social Security number from the government under his alias.

Turner said airline officials notified federal agents after seeing Malek Abdallah's name on a nationwide FBI watch list after the Sept. 11 attacks.

Seif, 36, who is in a Maricopa County jail, could not be reached for comment. In previous interviews, he has denied any link with terrorism and condemned the World Trade Center attacks. He has carried on a hunger strike since his arrest more than five weeks ago. Seif has acknowledged that he was acquainted with Hani Hanjour, the suicide-hijacker from Arizona who is believed to have crashed an American Airlines flight into the

The 41-count indictment includes new counts involving Seif's airline employment as well as fraud in other documents.

Tapes give clue to airliner's horrific end

Radio transmissions of doomed jet reveal struggle in cockpit

By Alan Levin and Laura Parker USA Today washington — Investigators are examining gruesome radio transmissions from the cockpit of a hijacked jet that include the sounds of the pilots being violently overcome and possibly murdered by terrorists, sources familiar with the investigation say.

They say the recorded transmissions, from a hijacked United Airlines flight that crashed in Pennsylvania without hitting a target on Sept. 11, offer a horrific glimpse of how hijackers surprised the two pilots by storming into the cockpit.

In the recording, a voice can be heard saying, "Get out of here, get out of here," possibly one of the pilots reacting to the sudden, forced entry.

The radio transmissions, each about 10 to 20 seconds long, contain the sounds of a "loud and violent encounter," said one person who had heard a tape of the transmissions. Another said it appeared the pilots were being murdered. Several people described the recording as deeply disturbing.

The cockpit struggle occurred on

board Flight 93, which took off from Newark Airport at 8:44 a.m. EDT Sept. 11 and crashed at 10:10 a.m. in Shanksville, Pa., about 80 miles southeast of Pittsburgh. Investigators say they believe the four hijackers who seized the flight were prevented from crashing it into a target by passengers who fought their way into the cockpit after the flight crew was murdered.

Cocputation management of the plant of the hijackings were carried out. Investigators are studying the taped transmissions as they continue to piece together how the quadruple hijackings were carried out. Investigators hope that by learning how the hijackings were accomplished, they will get additional clues about how the hijack teams prepared for their assignment and about who the team leaders were.

According to preliminary data from Flight 93's data recorder, the jet appears to have been flown intentionally into the ground at more than 575 mph, sources say.

The renewed focus on details of the crime came as the investigation into the worst act of terrorism committed on American soil expanded into

In Great Britain, authorities on Sunday were questioning an Algerian pilot who was taking flight training and whose name appeared on a list of more than 250 people wanted by the FBI for

questioning in the attacks.

The man, Lofti Raissi, 27, reportedly told conflicting stories about a trip he is said to have made to Phoenix at a time when at least one of the hijackers is believed to have been training there.

In Hamburg, Germany, police continued to search for Said Bahaji, 26, who once shared an apartment with hijacker Mohammed Atta. Atta is increasingly being viewed as the leader of the 19 hijackers who took over the four flights. A murder warrant issued last week alleged that Bahaji supplied the killers with technical assistance. The warrant was the first murder charge filed in the attacks.

In Dallas, the FBI was seeking to interview Ghassan Dahduli, 44, who was arrested in Richardson, Texas, on Saturday afternoon. Dahduli, a Palestinian who had been fighting deportation for visa fraud, was picked up after his bond in that case was revoked, FBI spokeswoman Lori Bailey said.

Dahduli also worked for an Internet Services company in Richardson, where federal agents seized records on Sept. 5, six days before the hijackings. Those records remain sealed.

Dahduli's name was found in the address book of another Texas man, Wadih el-Hage, who was convicted earlier this year in the plot to bomb the U.S. embassies in Kenya and Tanzania in

1998. Those bombings killed 224 people, including 12 Americans. El-Hage once worked as a secretary to Osama bin Laden, financier of Muslim extremist terrorists and the man the Bush administration says is behind the terrorist attacks Sept. 11.

El-Hage, in turn, was an associate of Moataz al-Hallak, a prayer leader at a mosque in the Dallas area who moved to Laurel, Md., last year.

Five hijackers lived in Laurel during the summer, shortly before taking over American Airlines Flight 77 out of Washington Dulles International Airport and crashing it into the Pentagon. The FBI interviewed Hallak about the hijackings for three hours last week.

The Federal Aviation Administration ordered all crop-dusting planes grounded today while the FBI continues to investigate whether terrorists planned to taint crop-dusting chemicals.

The chairman of the Air Line Pilots Association's national security committee said an undetermined number of airlines employees have turned up on the FBI's list of people wanted for questioning in the attacks, but none appears to be suspected of involvement.

"A lot of people on that list, they're not terrorists, per se," Steve Luckey said. "They're just people they wanted to talk to."



For the purpose of preparing its case in the United States vs. Zaccarias Moussaoui, the U.S. Department of Justice has asked the Federal Aviation Administration to query aviation safety inspectors to see if they had any interaction through flight school surveillance, accident or incident investigation, enforcement investigation, participation in the same training class, etc., with any of the individuals on the attached list. This list contains the true names and known aliases of the 19 hijackers killed on September 11, 2001, and six alleged co-conspirators which include Mr. Moussaoui and Osama bin Laden. (The Department of Justice notes that it is unlikely that bin Laden has taken any flight instruction, but any of the other 25 may have; and we need to have all of them checked under all aliases as well as true names.)

You have received this memorandum because the Department of Justice has identified four states in which some of these individuals took or may have taken flight instruction: Arizona, Florida, Oklahoma, and Minnesota. Please disseminate this list among all Flight Standards District Offices in your regions to determine if any aviation safety inspector recognizes that he or she had dealings with any of the names on the list. If an inspector believes that he

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or she may have encountered one of these individuals in the course of his or her duties, please provide the inspector's name, duty station and, a description of that encounter, along with any documentation (school records, PTRS, etc.) which may exist. Consolidate the responses and provide them to Ms. Phyllis Anne Duncan in the General Aviation and Commercial Division, AFS-800, no later than February 28. If there is a negative response, please provide that to her as well. If you have any questions concerning this, please contact Ms. Duncan at

If an inspector has already provided information to the FBI on any of these individuals, there is no need to provide that information again, but indicate what was provided to the FBI in broad terms, and if possible, the name of the FBI agent and the date provided.

Please consider this request of the utmost importance since it could be vital to the prosecution of the case, the United States vs. Zaccarias Moussaoui.


